

Troop 33 Summer Camp Checklist

Bags and Sleeping Gear

- Day Pack
- Back Pack or Duffel bag
- Therm-A-Rest or Inflatable mattress
- Sleeping bag
- Inflatable pillow (optional)

Clothing

- Class A uniform (full)
- Class B t-shirts (min. 5)
- Long pants (min. 1 pair)
- Short pants (min. 5 pair)
- Socks (6 pairs)
- Hiking shoes (waterproof is best)
- Athletic shoes (for backup)
- Underwear (6 pairs)
- Swim trunks (required for showers & swim test)
- Hat (optional)
- Windbreaker jacket
- Poncho or similar rain gear (anticipate rain)
- Slippers (for showers)
- Black trash bag (for dirty laundry)
- Wooden clothespins (6; mark your names)
- Small bottle laundry detergent (optional)
- Febreze laundry spray (optional)

Personal Gear

- Headlamp and flashlight
- Pocketknife & Totin Chip (optional)
- Folding chair or stool
- Wallet, photo ID, cash (recommend \$40)
- Prescription medication (turn in to medical officer)
- Mosquito repellent (w/deet)
- Sunscreen (compact)
- Hand sanitizer (compact)
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Bath towel and wash cloth
- Soap / shampoo
- Other personal items as required

Food & Drink

- Nalgene water bottle
- Personal snacks

Merit Badge Class Material

- Merit Badge books
- Merit Badge class supplies (e.g. Basketry)
- Scout Handbook (especially younger scouts)
- Notebook and pen / pencil

DO NOT BRING: Video games, MP3 players, other electronics

Cell phone: For emergency use only and shall be kept with personal gear. Scoutmaster may designate scout leadership to carry for communication purposes only - not for games.

Note to Scouts and Parents:

Class "A" uniforms are worn at morning and evening flag ceremonies, at mealtimes, and at campfires. At all other times during the day, scouts will wear Class "B" uniforms (troop t-shirt, long or short pants, and covered shoes).

Pupukea's weather is mostly cool and humid. Anticipate rainy periods throughout the day and evening and prepare for them. Wet clothes and towels may not dry quickly, so quick-dry fabrics are recommended.

Pupukea has a trading post where merit badge supplies are available. Please purchase your required supplies for classes such as Basketry, Wood Carving, and Leatherwork IN ADVANCE from Aloha Council as supplies at Pupukea are limited to stock on hand. Refreshments and souvenirs are also sold at the trading post.
